Dear Parents,

Math Masters is an extracurricular activity that encourages students to excel in math facts (addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division). The Math Master Xtra program will allow the students to work to increase speed and accuracy in arithmetic. Each student in Math Masters Xtra will have an *individualized program to follow which is catered to his or her needs, ability, and skill level.*

This year, Math Masters will be offered to students before school at 7:45am-8:15am in the computer lab once a month AND can be worked on AT HOME or on an iPad daily!

We will be *monitoring the progress your child is making and issuing certificates* as he or she masters the levels within the program.

Each student must be pre-registered using this form. You will be sent *a student enrollment code and PIN* via the classroom teacher after the registration form is received.

Monthly "drop-in sessions" will start the week of September 12, 13, & 14, 2017; however, the students can complete the program at home as well, which is encouraged!
